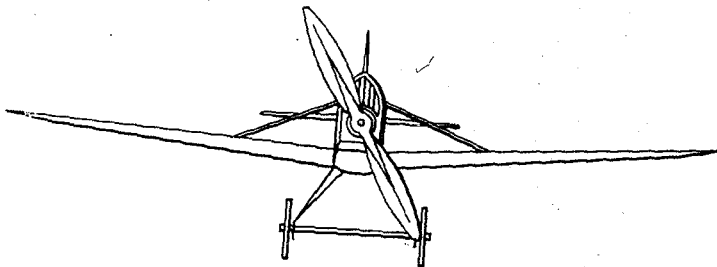
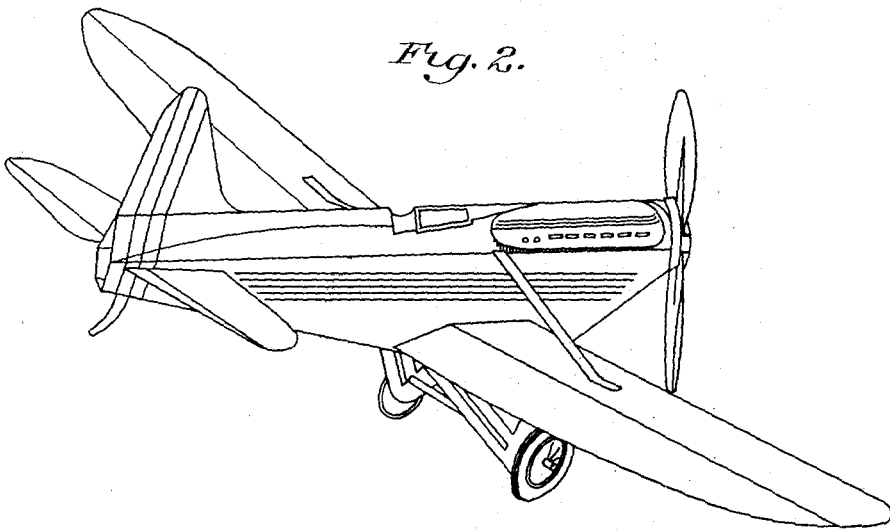

DESIGN FOR A TOY AEROPLANE

Application filed May 19, 1932. Serial No. 43,850. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WALLIS RIGBY, a British subject, of 24a Beverley Road, Anerley, London, S. E. 20., have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Toy Aeroplanes, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing, Figure 1 is a front elevation and Figure 2 is a perspective view of a toy aeroplane embodying the new design

comprising primarily the distinctive, longitudinally straight line effect and the peculiar cross sectional shape of the body thereof, together with the disposition of the wings relative to said body substantially as shown.
